



ILKLEY GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE

The general principle is that all golfers will conform to a high standard of dress, both on and off the course. In order to encourage such standards, there follows a guide illustrating what is and what is not acceptable in the Club.

Specific functions may have slightly different requirements - jacket and tie, for example.

CLUBHOUSE AND 19TH

Acceptable: Clean and dry golf attire, including non-spike shoes **before** playing, or other smart/casual clothing.

Not acceptable: Wet or dirty golf attire; t-shirts; track-suit tops or bottoms; rugby or football shirts; denim; jeans; combat/cargo/beach/board shorts; any headwear; gym trainers/flip-flops/Crocs/sliders; any golf shoes **after** playing (except the 19th)

CARD AND DINING ROOMS

As above, but no golf shoes at any time.

TERRACE

As for the Clubhouse, but headwear may be worn.

COURSE, INCLUDING PRACTICE GROUND

Acceptable: Recognised ladies' and gentlemen's golf attire, including golf-shoes with socks.

Not acceptable: t-shirts; track-suit tops or bottoms; rugby or football shirts; denim; jeans; combat/cargo/beach/board shorts.
